This summer, I have provided students with a comprehensive packet of math review that will keep them fresh and ready to enter 6th grade with confidence. **The packet has enough pages that students could finish it by doing one page a day, six days per week.**

In addition to the packet, students are **encouraged to practice their skills with Dreambox** (I won't be able to give assignments, but the program should adjust to their level over time and extend to new content), or **Kahn Academy** to review 5th grade skills and preview 6th grade.

These packets should be **finished by the end of summer and turned in to their 6th grade math teacher on the first day of school.** Families and students are, of course, very busy during the school year. Please do your best to help your child budget their time to finish the packet. If something comes up and it isn't possible for them to finish, please have your child write a letter of explanation that you both sign to give to their teacher next year.
