EXTENDED DAY OPTIONS

Extended Day programming is offered Monday through Friday at the rate of \$15/hour for preschool through eighth grade students. For more frequent users, an unlimited **FALL 2019** semester option of **\$1,350** is available for preschool through elementary students and **\$702** for middle school students. This flat fee covers care from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm on school days from August 21- December 20, 2019. Please note there is a fee for before care from 7:30-8:00 am if families have not signed up for unlimited care at the rate of \$15/hr or \$8 per 30 minutes.

Index Tuition discounts will be applied to care and one enrichment class and codes will be emailed to respective families.

Additional payment is required for before care between teacher workshop days (October 9), vacation camps (details TBD), and evening events.

In addition to drop-in programming, a variety of enrichment classes are available with an additional activity fee. Extended Day hourly fees do not apply during the class but do incur from the time of class dismissal until your child is picked up from school. Registration for enrichment classes and the unlimited extended day option are through an online enrollment management system, <https://www.sfschool.org/school-life/extended-day/>. Please note this system is separate from both the SFS Today Parent Portal and Kinderlime and new users will need to create a username and password to access the list of courses.

GUITAR LESSONS WITH SEBASTIAN QUINTERO

4TH - 8TH Grade

Sebastian Quintero is a lutenist and guitarist from Tacoma, Washington. Growing up, Quintero was immersed in a wide variety of music, ranging from Jazz, Bluegrass, Classical, Folk, and Flamenco. In his professional life Quintero plays with several groups on several instruments including baroque lute, flamenco guitar, classical guitar, and electric guitar. Quintero holds a degree from The San Francisco Conservatory of Music, where he studied classical guitar with famed guitarist Marc Teicholz, and received an emphasis in early music under lutenist Richard Savino.

Quintero has played in several notable performances, such as Mahler's symphony no. 7 with the Berkeley Symphony, Handel's Tamerlano with the San Francisco Conservatory Baroque Ensemble, and was a featured soloist at the Bellevue Jazz Festival in Bellevue Washington.

As well as a steady performance schedule, Quintero maintains a full teaching schedule in the Bay Area. Quintero has studied guitar pedagogy with famed teacher Larry Ferrara, and has taught for 12 years both in music schools, and privately. Quintero currently teaches at the California Conservatory of Music.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

My child is interested in a class that ends at 4:30 pm. Will I be charged if I do not pick up at 4:30?

- Yes, students will be charged for any portion of time after their class ends at the \$15 per hour rate.

What if the class doesn't reach the minimum numbers?

- Under enrolled courses will be cancelled and families who have registered informed via email prior to the start of the class.

What if the class surpasses the maximum number?

- Over enrolled classes will generate a waitlist for students in the case of a cancellation.

My child wants to take an instrumental lesson, what is the process?

- Email Sharon Ng sng@sfschool.org to state preference for instrument and availability.
- Instrumental lesson schedules will be arranged and families informed of lesson days/times.
- In the case of a missed lesson, please inform the instrumental music teacher, the front desk, and Sharon the morning before the lesson. No refunds will be given for missed classes and it is up to the teacher's discretion to reschedule.

What are the procedures for signing my child in and out of Extended Day?

- Students in Elementary and Middle School are signed into the Extended Day program from dismissal using the Kinderlime iPad application.
- Students are signed out from the Extended Day program at the Front Desk upon arrival of their guardian for pickup. Authorized guardians will sign the child out using the Kinderlime iPad application. Students who are not signed out will automatically be signed out at 6:00 pm.
- Preschool students are signed in and out across from the Preschool Extended Day Room using the Kinderlime iPad application and each user's unique four digit code.

What if I am late for Pick Up?

- Students still waiting at the end of the white zone at 3:25 pm will be signed into their choice of Extended Day drop-in options (Study Hall, All Sports with Legarza, Learning Lab, etc.)

- Once the authorized guardian has arrived, the student will be signed out at the Front Desk and be charged the hourly rate.
