

If a staff or student

Is symptomatic:



Do not come to campus;
Notify the school;
Isolate for 10 days
OR
Get tested and isolate at home
while awaiting results

Tests negative

Isolate at home
until you feel better.

Once 24 hours have
passed without a fever
(without taking fever-
reducing medication),
you may return to campus.

May participate in
distance learning if feeling
well enough.



Tests positive

Notify the school.
Isolate at home until
recovered

If symptomatic

Isolate at home at least 10 days
from initial symptoms AND
until 24 hours have passed
without fever (without
taking fever-reducing
medication) and other
symptoms have improved



If asymptomatic

Isolate at home
10 days from test date

If a household member or close contact of a staff member or student

Tests positive

Staff or Student should:
Notify the school.
Quarantine at home for
14 days from exposure to
positive household or
close contact(s) to see if
you develop symptoms
and prevent passing
onto anyone else

The School 
will notify SFPD &
the whole school community

Cohort
Quarantine for 14 days.
Undergo testing.
Transition to SOTG

substitute teacher.
