If a staff or student

Is symptomatic:



Do not come to campus;

Notify the school; **Isolate** for 10 days OR Get tested and isolate at home while awaiting results

If symptomatic

Isolate at home at least 10 days

from initial symptoms AND

until 24 hours have passed without fever (without taking fever-reducing

medication) and other

symptoms have improved

Tests negative

Isolate at home until you feel better.

Once 24 hours have passed without a fever (without taking feverreducing medication), you may return to campus.

May participate in distance learning if feeling well enough.



If a household member or close contact of a staff member or student

Tests positive

Staff or Student should: Notify the school. **Quarantine** at home for 14 days from exposure to positive household or close contact(s) to see if you develop symptoms and prevent passing onto anyone else

The School (1)

will notify the cohort(s)

Cohort

continues to attend school on campus.

If staff, then substitute teacher. If student, then remote learning.

will notify SFDPH & the whole school community

Cohort



Quarantine for 14 days. Undergo testing. **Transition to SOTG**

If asymptomatic

Isolate at home 10 days from test date



Tests positive

Notify the school.

Isolate at home until recovered
